Board of Education Meetings - Quorum	B.18
Adopted: July 23, 2013	

A quorum consisting of a majority of the board membership shall be necessary to conduct business. In the event that a quorum is not present and a regularly scheduled board meeting cannot be convened, the meeting shall be cancelled. If a regularly scheduled board meeting is cancelled due to lack of a quorum, a notice of such cancellation shall be immediately prepared and posted with the original agenda of the cancelled meeting. A special meeting may then be called with the appropriate minimum of 48 hours' notice to the county clerk. The agenda for the special meeting shall include all of the items listed on the agenda of the regular meeting.
