The school district will operate a school lunch program that will include lunches and may include breakfast, through participation in the national school lunch program. The superintendent/administrative assistant in conjunction with the food service supervisor will establish and post meal prices prior to the beginning of each school year.

As required for participation in the national school lunch program, the board prescribes:

- 1. That school lunch be made available to all students.
- 2. That free and reduced price lunches be made available for students who meet the federal income guidelines. Qualifications for free and reduced-price lunches will vary annually in accordance with the annual eligibility schedule. Forms for free and reduced-price lunches are available in the school office.
- 3. Students may either purchase a lunch or bring a lunch from home. All students may eat lunch in the cafeteria and other designated areas.
- 4. Foods of minimal nutritional value will not be sold from vending machines while reimbursable meals are being sold.
- 5. Funds received from the school lunch program shall be used only for the purchase of food, equipment necessary for the preparation of meals, and for the salaries of those employees necessary for the operation of the program.
- 6. Weekly lunch tickets will be sold in the school office before school and will be retained in the office for daily use.
- 7. There will be no lunch charges for high school and middle school students. Elementary students may charge no more then three lunches.
