The Board of Education recognizes that students do not surrender any rights of citizenship while in attendance at Hilldale Public Schools. This includes the right to engage in peaceful protest. However, the United States Supreme Court has ruled that students do not have the right to engage in protest activities that materially and substantially interfere with the operation of the school. Because students have no right to disrupt school, any student who participates in a student walkout or otherwise refuses to attend class or other scheduled academic activities during the school day shall be subject to discipline. Disciplinary options shall include, but shall not be limited to, detention, alternative school and suspension out of school.
