The Hilldale Board of Education believes that the right of a student to participate fully in classroom instruction, other educational activities, services and programs shall not be abridged or impaired because of race, color, sex, pregnancy, gender, gender expression or identity, national origin, religion, disability, veteran status, sexual orientation, age, or genetic information, or for any other reason not related to individual capability.

The right of a student to participate in extracurricular activities shall be dependent only upon the maintenance of minimum academic, attendance and behavior standards established by the board and the O.S.S.A.A. and the student's individual ability in the extracurricular activity.
