(through observation, experience or research)




Facts about Facts

- Give specific information
- Definite statements.
- Often contain numbers, dates, or ages



Fact Clue Words

Research, proven,
authentic, etc.

ABLE TO BE PROVEN!**

2. **Most buses weigh more than most cars.**
3. **There are ten inches in a foot.
(false)**

proven.



Facts about Opinions

- Opinions are judgements
- They tell what people think, feel, or believe



Opinion Clue Words

Believe, feel, think,
most, best, should,
worst, etc.
