Important Dates at NWOSU

- **Saturday, November 12, 2022 – Ranger Preview** – All high school seniors in attendance will receive a \$600 scholarship, free lunch, t-shirt, Ranger football game tickets, and much more! Campus and dorm tours will be provided. All college application fees are waived for attendees of this event. *Juniors will receive all of the above; however, they will only be eligible for the \$600 scholarship if they attend the event during their senior year of high school.*
- **Saturday, February 25, 2023 – Spring Showcase** – Extra opportunity for high school seniors to visit campus and earn \$500 scholarship, free lunch, t-shirt, attend a home Ranger baseball game, and much more! All college application fees are waived for attendees of this event. *Juniors will receive all of the above; however, they will only be eligible for the \$500 scholarship if they attend the event as a senior. The Spring Showcase Scholarship of \$500 cannot be stacked on top of the Ranger Preview Scholarship of \$600.*
- **Monday, March 6, 2023 – President’s Leadership Class Scholarship Application Deadline** -- \$2,750 scholarship, trip to a major U.S. city, and the opportunity to take a leadership course under the instruction of our Northwestern President.
- **Wednesday, April 12, 2023 – Freshman Connection** – Official first day classes open for 2023 Fall enrollment for incoming freshman. At this event, potential freshman can come to NWOSU for a tour and meet with an advisor to enroll in their classes for the upcoming semester. They can also take care of their housing applications.
