To be admitted as a concurrent student:

Provide official ACT or SAT scores  
(Minimum composite score of  
19 ACT or 1010 SAT)

**OR**

Minimum unweighted  
GPA of 3.0

- Complete the online Concurrent Application for Admission
  - Permission from Parent or Guardian
  - Permission from High School Principal or Counselor
- Provide your most recent high school transcript

To enroll concurrently in a specific course subject:

19 ACT Subscore **OR**  
SAT Subscore Equivalent **OR**  
Placement Exam at RSU

## Enrollment Process:

- Must be admitted
- Speak with HS counselor about courses
- Speak with parents
- Schedule appointment and meet with RSU advisor
- Enroll!
