

THE U.S. ARMY NATIONAL GUARD **GFRD SCHOLARSHIP** 2023-2024 CAMPAIGN

The Minuteman Campaign is a US Cadet Command initiative to offer Guaranteed Reserve Forces Duty (GRFD) Scholarships to candidates that self-select for service in a National Guard or Reserve Component.

SCHOLARSHIP OVERVIEW

- The GFRD campaign awards 2-, 2.5-, 3-, 3.5-, 4-year scholarships.
- Public, Non-resident or private schools authorized.
- Will be academically aligned to start and end the
- scholarship by graduation date and commission.
- Graduate degrees eligible.
- All scholarships are based on available funding.
- Current Guard and Reserve members are eligible

How to Apply:

- Meet all scholarship qualifications/ requirements
- Seek a nomination and interview with the Professor of Military Science (PMS)
- Contact Captain Brent Welch to start the process

BENEFITS

- Covers full tuition and fees OR room and board (\$10,000 per year)
- Monthly \$420 Cadet stipend (freshmen-senior year)
- Annual \$1,200 book stipend
- Earn E-5 drill pay upon contracting
- Guaranteed commission in the Oklahoma National Guard with an eight-year service obligation

REQUIREMENTS

-Minimum test scores: SAT = 850 or ACT = 19 or GT = 110 -2.5 Cumulative GPA -Official college/university acceptance letter -Currently Enlisted or eligible to enlist -Must be a U.S. citizen or U.S. National -Meet physical fitness requirements -Between age of 17-28 -GRFD MM scholarship recipients cannot compete for active duty

-Eligible to participate in the Simultaneous Membership Program (SMP) with a National Guard unit of your choice
