VIRTUAL LEARNING SUPPORT PROGRAM

This program provides assistance to students whose learning opportunities have been negatively impacted as a result of the COVID-19 Pandemic. Eligible students and scholars may receive a one-time stipend of \$850 to support technology needs that support virtual learning.

ELIGIBILITY:

- Must be a citizen of The Muscogee Nation. (Citizenship will be verified)
- Must be currently enrolled in Pre-K 12, or has full-time status in a Vocational-Technical Program, Post-Secondary, or Graduate School.
 - Must provide proof of enrollment. Report cards will NOT be accepted.
 - All institutions must be accredited.
 - Full-time vocational programs must be at least 9 months long.
 - Full-time college status is 12 credit hours or more; 6+ hours for graduate level
- Student must NOT have previously received the 2020 Virtual Learning Assistance or MCN Accessing Choices in Education (ACE) Educational Materials support service for technology. (Assistance will be verified)
- Students pursuing a GED are not eligible.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- Students under the age of 18 must have a parent/guardian complete the application. Parent/Guardian applying for the child must be the custodial parent, legal guardian, foster parent, or caseworker at the time the application is processed. The parent/guardian applying for the student is NOT required to be a tribal citizen. Verification of guardianship or other documents may be requested, as needed.
- Payment will be issued in the form of a check.
- Assistance is based on funding availability.
- Reimbursements are NOT allowed.
- Purchases are NOT tax exempt.
