But children lack adult experience and judgement. They need behavior boundaries. They **need** someone to look to for strength, protection and guidance.

The key is to remember **that you are the adult, and you are in charge.** You have the maturity. You have the experience. Children don’t. Only an adult can establish the limits of acceptable behavior in your household. With loving firmness and authority you must establish the rules and enforce them.
